Implementation of the educational program for young detainees

Welcome to the SEMELI project's second newsletter!

We are happy to announce that the implementation of the educational program for young detainees of the SEMELI project has started, with some partners already delivering the program and other partners having finalized their scheduling for the upcoming months.

After a productive period of extensive collaboration with all partners and the exchange of ideas and good practices, the Theological School of the Church of Cyprus, as coordinator of Work Package 3, has successfully designed a high-quality educational program specifically tailored to the needs of young detainees. The educational materials aim to address the digital and media exclusion of young individuals, who are socially and geographically marginalized.

Educational program for young detainees

The digital inclusion curriculum for young detainees was developed based on previous successful programs (PEBBLE, ELMIP, EMCI) and other evidence-based programs, enriched with new innovative elements. The content of the young detainees' curriculum is organized in the following four basic sections:

- 1. Digital skills and literacy
- 2. Media literacy
- 3. Role model testimonials
- 4. Small project, VR and Robotics workshops

Methodology of the Educational Program for Young Detainees

The teaching methodology of the educational program involves innovative pedagogical models that go beyond traditional modes of training. These involve:

- Interactive workshops
- Role-playing
- Creative constructions
- Group work
- Discussions
- Gamification
- Role model testimonials
- Small project creating a digital or a media idea
- Active participation of trained selected prison staff

Content Material: Thematic Units of the Educational Program for Young Detainees

Included in the Model developed is specialized material that has been produced, in a customized way, to better meet the needs of its main beneficiaries, the young detainees.

The content material of the educational program for young detainees consists of, and is organized in, the following 20 thematic units, which are themselves assigned in the four main sections described above:
